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When someone who loves shoes as much as Angela Self opens a “luxury shoe boutique,” one must go, if only to sit on a brown mohair ottoman and sip Perrier and ogle the Gunmetal peep-toe sandals that Halle Berry wore to the Emmys. At \$530, you might not be able to afford them, but it feels rich just to try them on.

POSH on Main, an inviting boutique that displays shoes by Alexandra Neel and Miss Trish of Capri like the works of art they are, opens at noon today with a trunk show by starlet-inspired designer label Hbillywould.

“I’m buying brands and styles that you can’t find in Bellevue, or Seattle for that matter, but that are [sold] at Bergdorf’s in New York and Harrods in London,” says Self, 35.

The store is designed to feel like a woman’s shoe closet – albeit one with chandeliers – and caters to both “uptown” (sophisticated) and “downtown” (edgy and fun) customers. POSH on Main (425-454-2022) is located at 10245 Main St. in Bellevue.
